ELEMENT DOG TRAINING

Find It

- Definition
 - o Teaches the dog to find an object throw by the owner
- Purpose
 - o Engages your dog's foraging instinct and supports recall
- Process
 - o Stand in front of your dog
 - o Show the dog a treat or some food
 - Say "Find It" then toss the treat 2-3 feet from your dog. Make sure the food stays visible for the entire toss
 - o Recall the dog or wait for it to reengage with you and repeat
 - o Start to vary the distance, direction, or surface that the treat is thrown
 - Tossing into something like short grass create a fun exploration activity
- > Work on generalizing the behavior by practicing in different environments

- Common mistakes when teaching touch:
 - o Throwing the treat to far away or in to difficult an environment
 - o Using a treat that isn't interesting enough for your dog to pick up
 - Increasing the difficulty too quickly. Moving too fast make the food to hard to find and stop being fun for your dog
